Four or more School Board members may be in attendance at the Kenosha Area Business Alliance, the KABA Foundation, and its partners for the groundbreaking of its new facility that will serve as the future home to LakeView Technology Academy and Gateway Technical College students at the Kenosha Innovation Neighborhood (KIN) located approximately between 30<sup>th</sup> & 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenues and 52<sup>nd</sup> & 60<sup>th</sup> Streets on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 at 10:00 A.M.

Section 19.82(2), Wisconsin Statutes, states in part as follows:

*If one-half or more of the members of a governmental body are present, the meeting is rebuttably presumed to be for the purposes of exercising the responsibilities, authority, power or duties delegated to or vested in the body.*

To the extent that four or more members of the School Board attend, the above-listed hearing may be rebuttably presumed to be a meeting within the meaning of Wisconsin's open meeting law. Notice is, therefore, given. The Board of Education will take no votes.
